Most recently, Perryman mini-grants have been awarded to teachers/programs in elementary and secondary schools in Lancaster, Long Beach, Los Angeles, and Torrance School Districts.

Each grant will be made for programs not to exceed the amount of \$1,000; applications for lesser amounts are also greatly encouraged, but all are limited to one per teacher, department, or program. Applicants will be notified in time to purchase materials for the beginning of the spring semester of 2012.
